ANTI-DOPING POLICY
Accepted by board February 7, 2017

DEFINITIONS

1. These terms will have these meanings in this policy:
 - a) "CCES" – Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport.
 - b) "Individual"- All categories of membership defined in the Flatwater Yukon Bylaws, as well as to all individuals engaged in activities with Flatwater Yukon, including, but not limited to, athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, directors, officers and team managers
 - c) "WADA" – World Anti-Doping Agency.

BACKGROUND AND POSITION STATEMENT

2. Flatwater Yukon is unequivocally opposed, on ethical, medical and Legal grounds to the practice of doping in sport and fully supports the position of International Olympic Committee, the Canadian Olympic Association, Sport Canada, the World Anti-Doping Agency, and the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport and the Yukon Sport & Recreation Branch against the use, possession and supply of banned substances and methods in sport.
3. Flatwater Yukon will continue to promote this position and will encourage its territorial partners to work together in support of a drug-free environment.

APPLICATION

4. This Policy applies to all Members as defined in the Definitions section.
5. Flatwater Yukon will respect any penalty enacted pursuant to a breach of the Canadian Anti-Doping Program, whether imposed by WADA, CCES, Yukon Sport & Rec Branch or Flatwater Yukon.

POLICY STATEMENT

6. Flatwater Yukon recognizes the role of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) in setting global standards, coordinating anti-doping worldwide and implementing all portions of the World Anti-Doping Program.
7. The Canadian Anti-Doping Program is administered on behalf of WADA by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) and Flatwater Yukon accepts and adopts the designated authority and policies of the CCES on all anti-doping matters.
8. For further clarity, Flatwater Yukon has adopted and agrees to abide by the Canadian Anti-Doping Program as the anti-doping policy and regulations of Flatwater Yukon, as administered by the CCES, and as it may be amended from time to time.



9. Flatwater Yukon will comply with the Canadian Anti-Doping Program guidelines with respect to public announcements of positive test results.

SANCTIONS

11. ALL Individuals and persons sanctioned by virtue of the Canadian Anti-Doping Program will be ineligible to participate in any role and in any competition or activity organized, convened, held or sanctioned by Flatwater Yukon.

12. Flatwater Yukon may apply further sanctions or penalties in accordance with Flatwater Yukon's Code of Conduct and Ethics, or its Discipline Policy.
